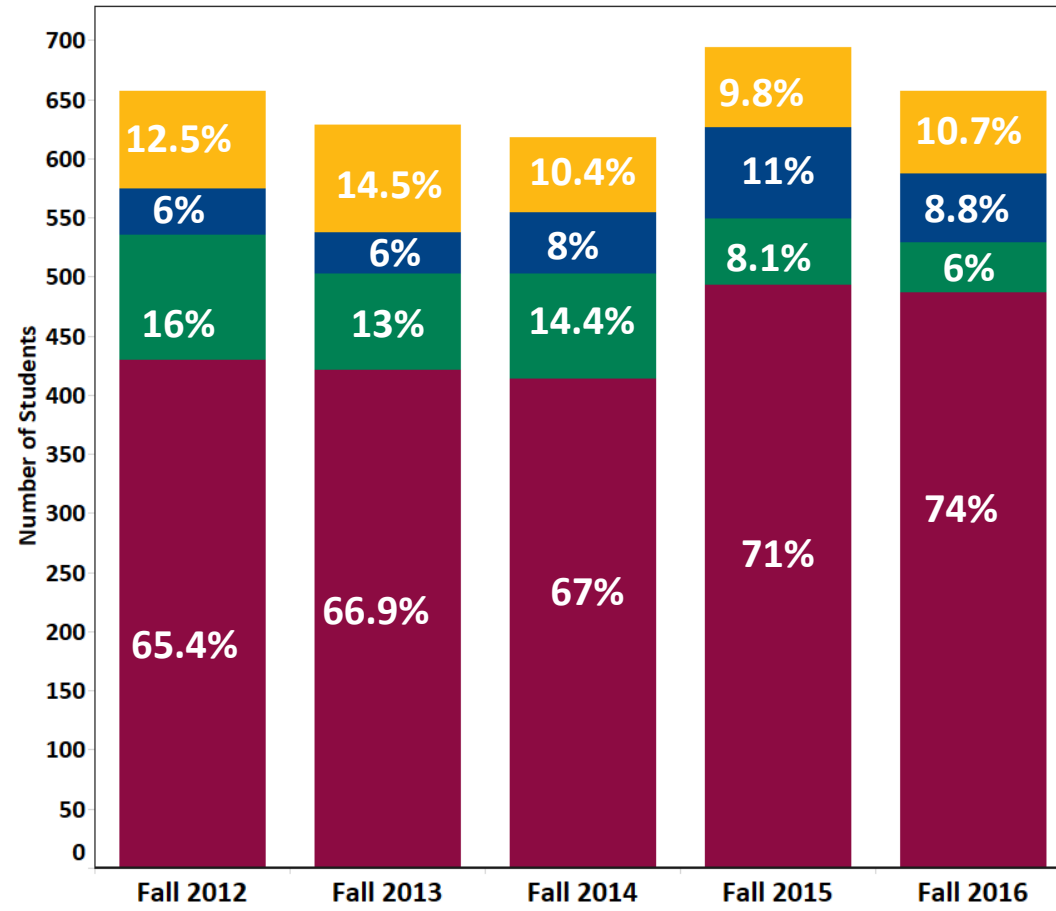

NMSU Main Campus, First-time Entering Students Graduating From Area* High Schools, Number and Percent of Students Enrolling in Developmental Courses

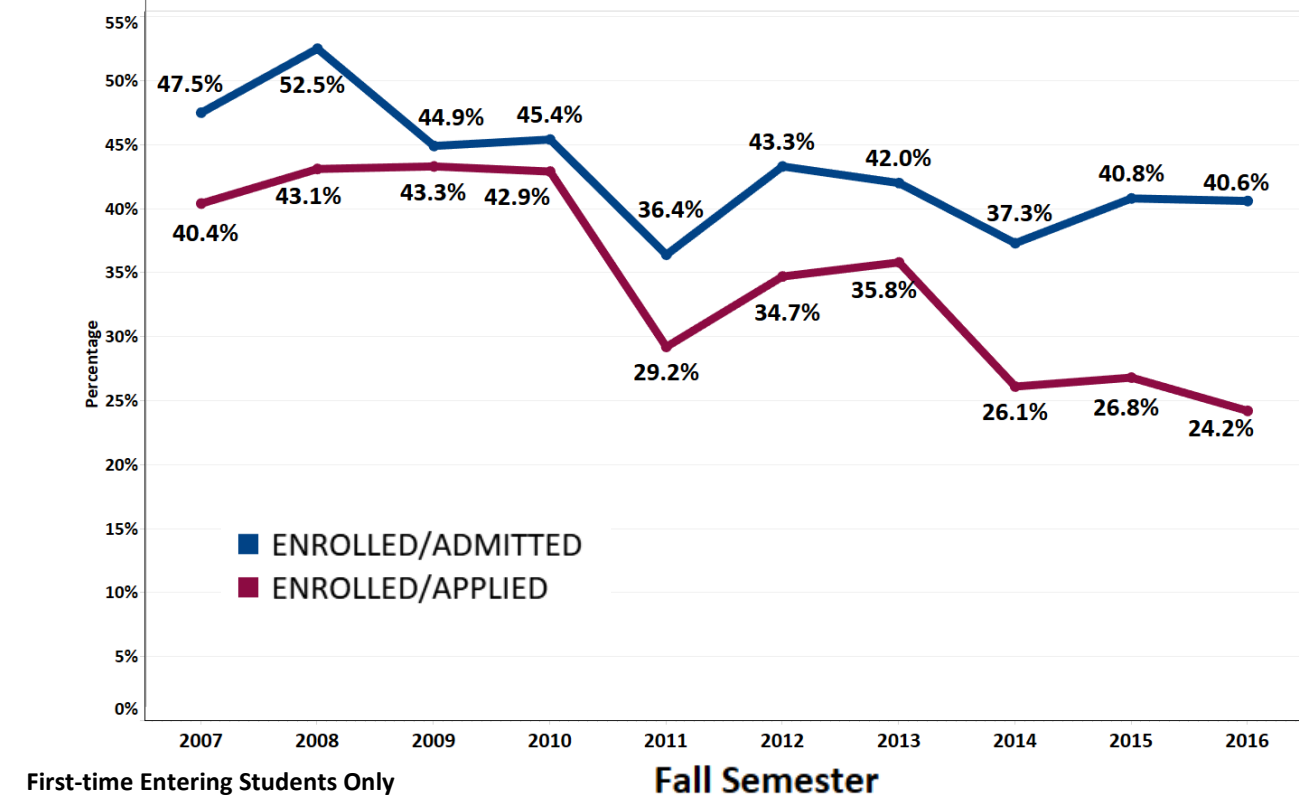
REMEDIAL COURSES

- No Remedial

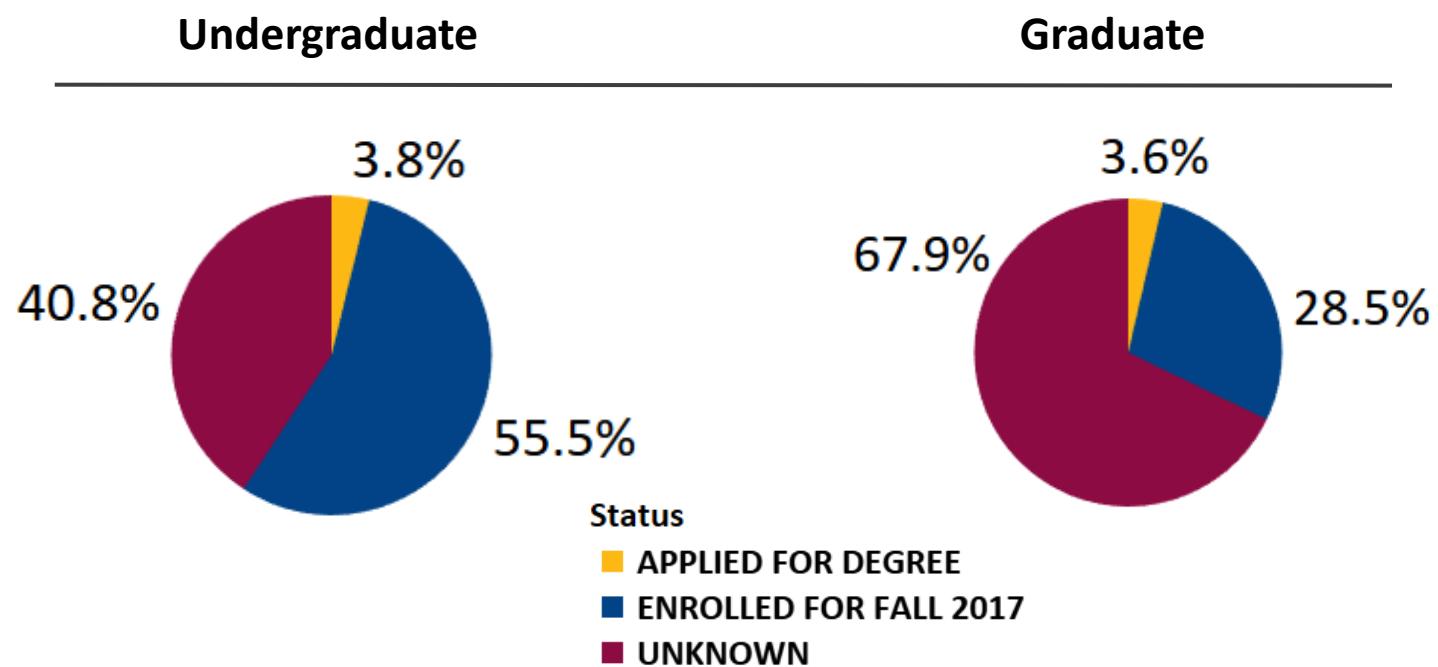

By the Numbers

169 main campus students have at least **ONE** major on **another campus**

5.5% of students have **MORE THAN** one major

10.7% of College of Business students have **MORE THAN** one major

Gainful Employment Programs

What is a gainful employment program?

- A certificate or graduate certificate (a program that does not lead to a degree)
- Title IV eligible
- A program that prepares students for employment

What do we have to report?

- Tuition & fees
- Books & supplies
- Room & board costs to complete entire program
- Student loan debt
- Number of students in the program
- Number of students graduating

What are the requirements?

- Must post link to disclosure page on home page of program's web site
- Must include this link: <https://www.nmsu.edu/gainfulemployment/> in **any published media** about the program
- Must update annually

Do we have to report all programs?

- YES**, if there are
- >10 students enrolled
 - >10 enrolled with debt
 - >10 who graduate within normal time
 - >10 who graduate with debt
