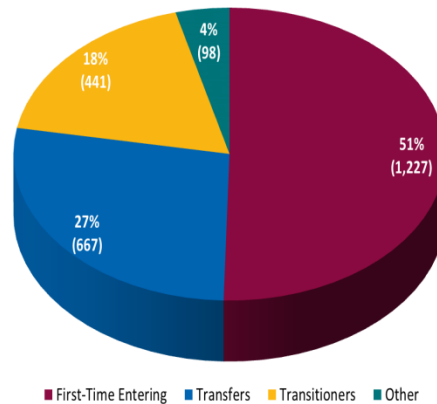
"I feel that I have gotten a high quality education at a fraction of the cost."

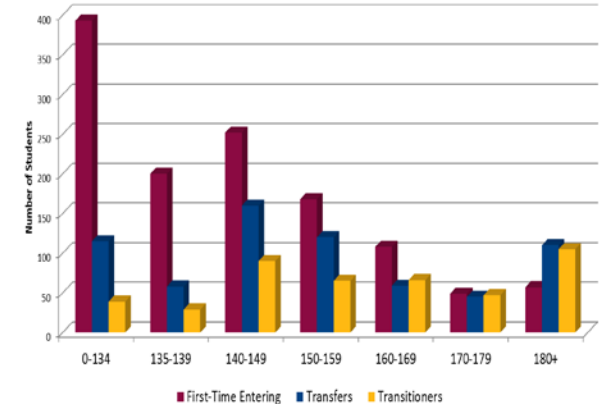

NMSU-Las Cruces



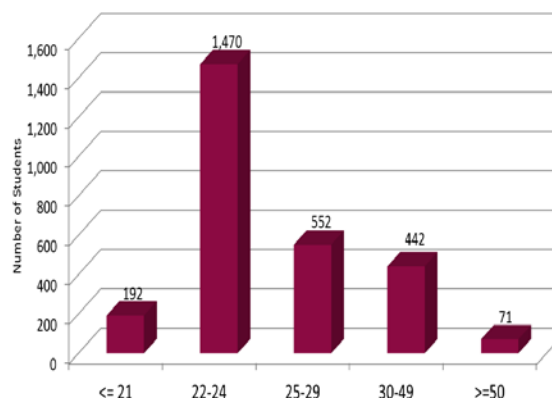
Transfers = Outside NMSU Transitioners = Transfer from within NMSU

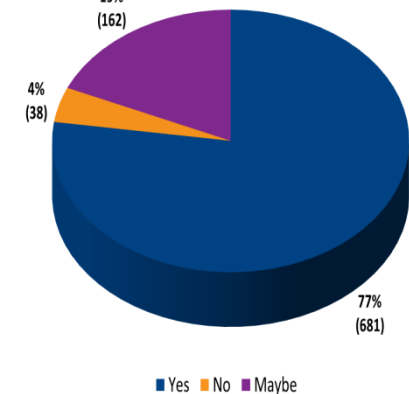

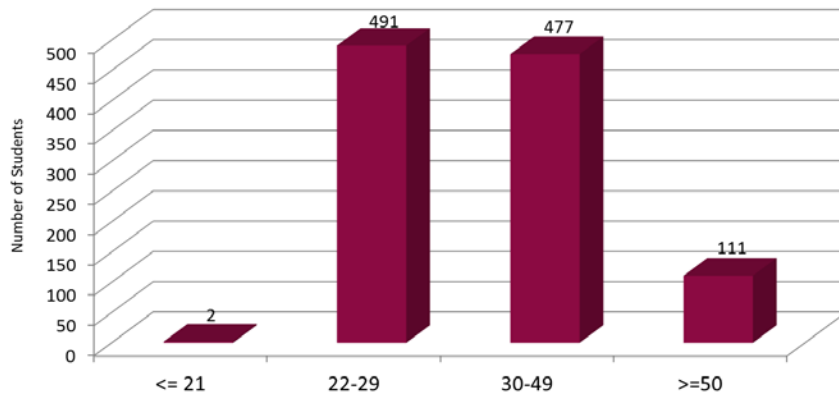
Undergraduate Students: Would You Attend NMSU Again?

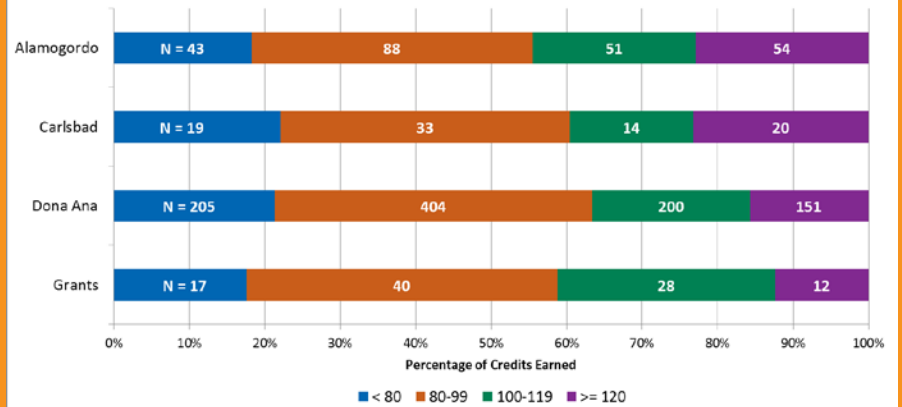

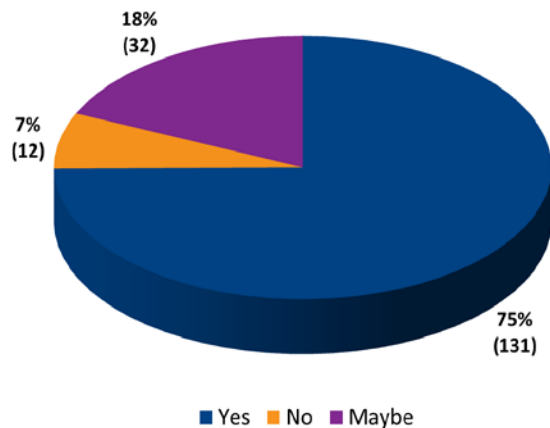
Age of Graduating Class (Graduate), 2013-14

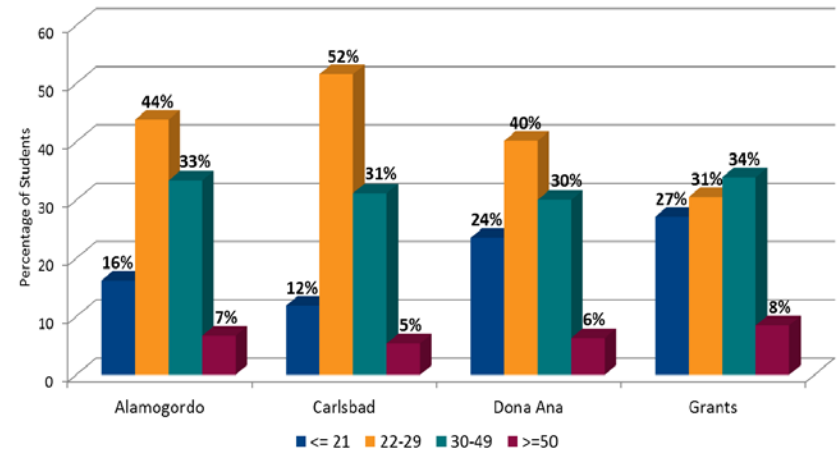
Credits Earned by Credit Range of Associate Degree Recipients, 2012-13
