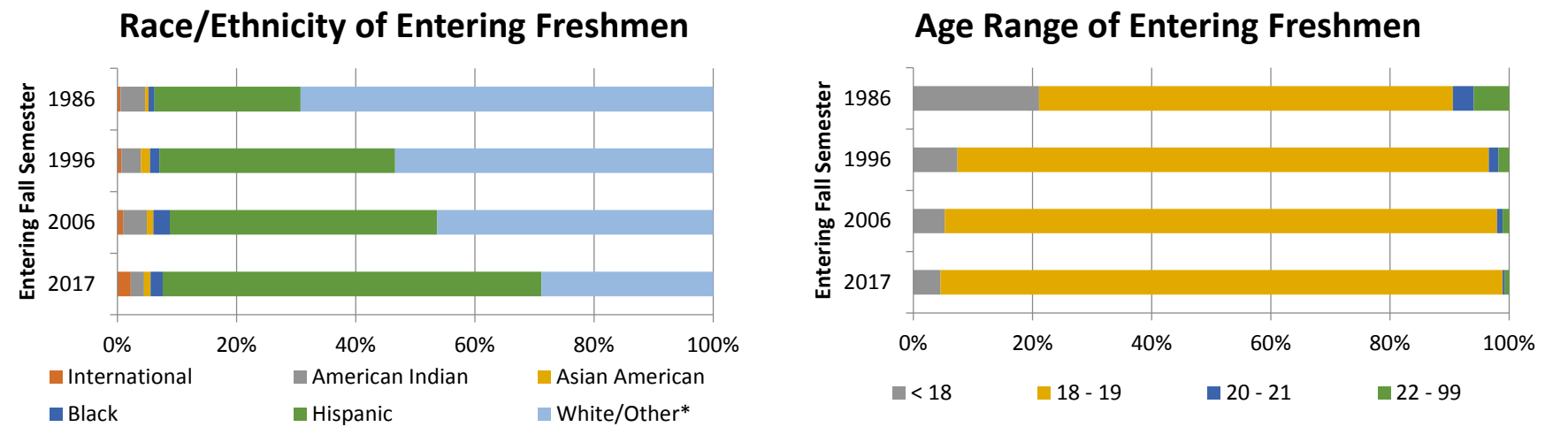
In late February, Vice President Roush appointed an ad hoc committee "to study all matters related to student retention and prepare a summary and recommendations for the Council."

The following recommendations were submitted:

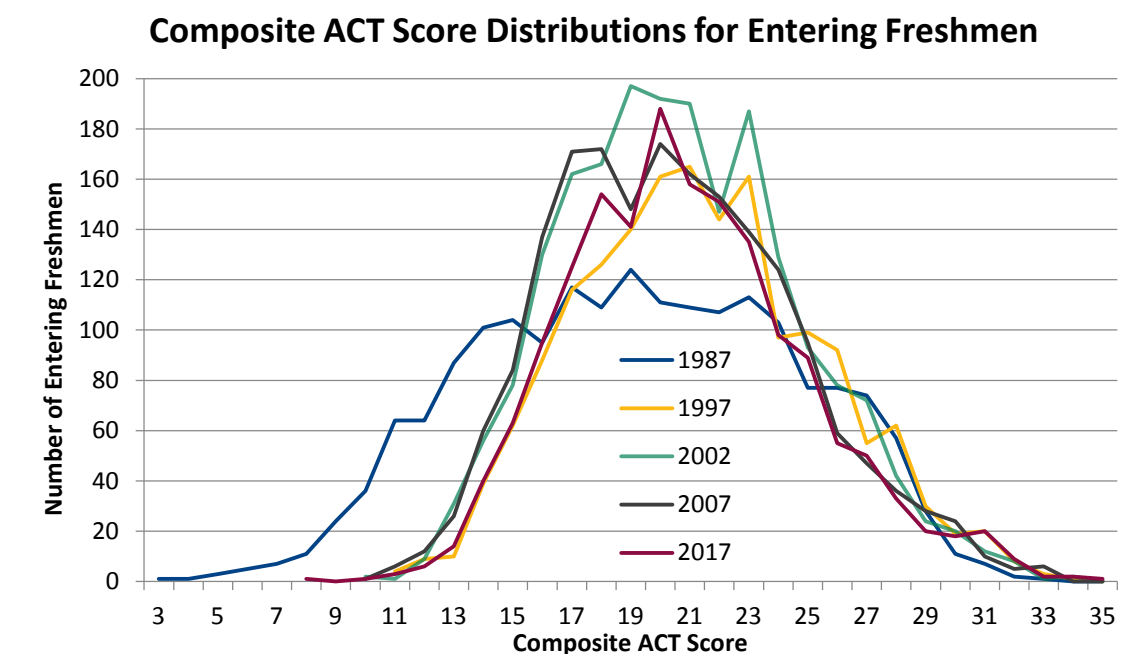
1. Appoint a Retention Committee
2. Hire a full-time professional staff member
3. Improve faculty-student interaction
4. Improve instruction and academic programs
5. Develop a coordinated program of academic advising and career counseling
6. Improve the quality of peer interaction
7. Increase on-campus employment opportunities
8. Expand orientation activities for all students
9. Identify high-risk students and provide special assistance
10. Present a meaningful and accurate picture of the institution

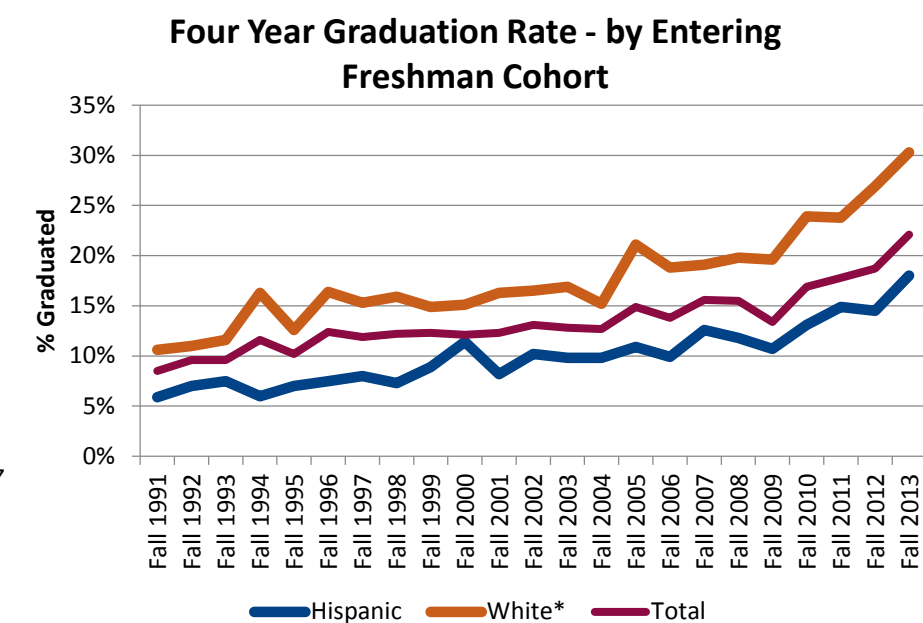
Has the Entering Freshman Composition changed over time?

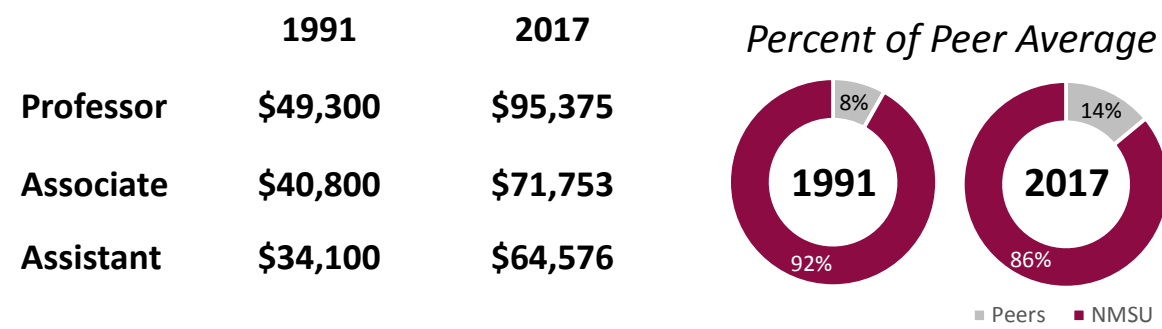

NMSU Las Cruces Faculty...

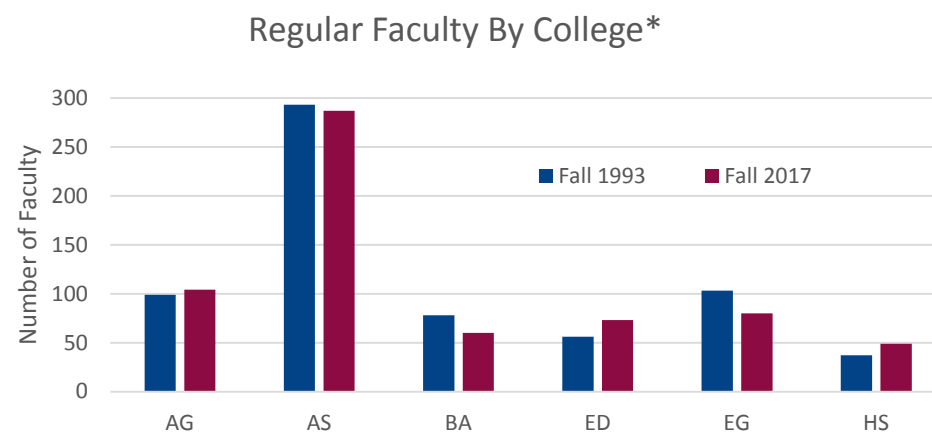
Salaries have increased, but continue to lag behind peers.

Number of regular faculty by college has "varied."

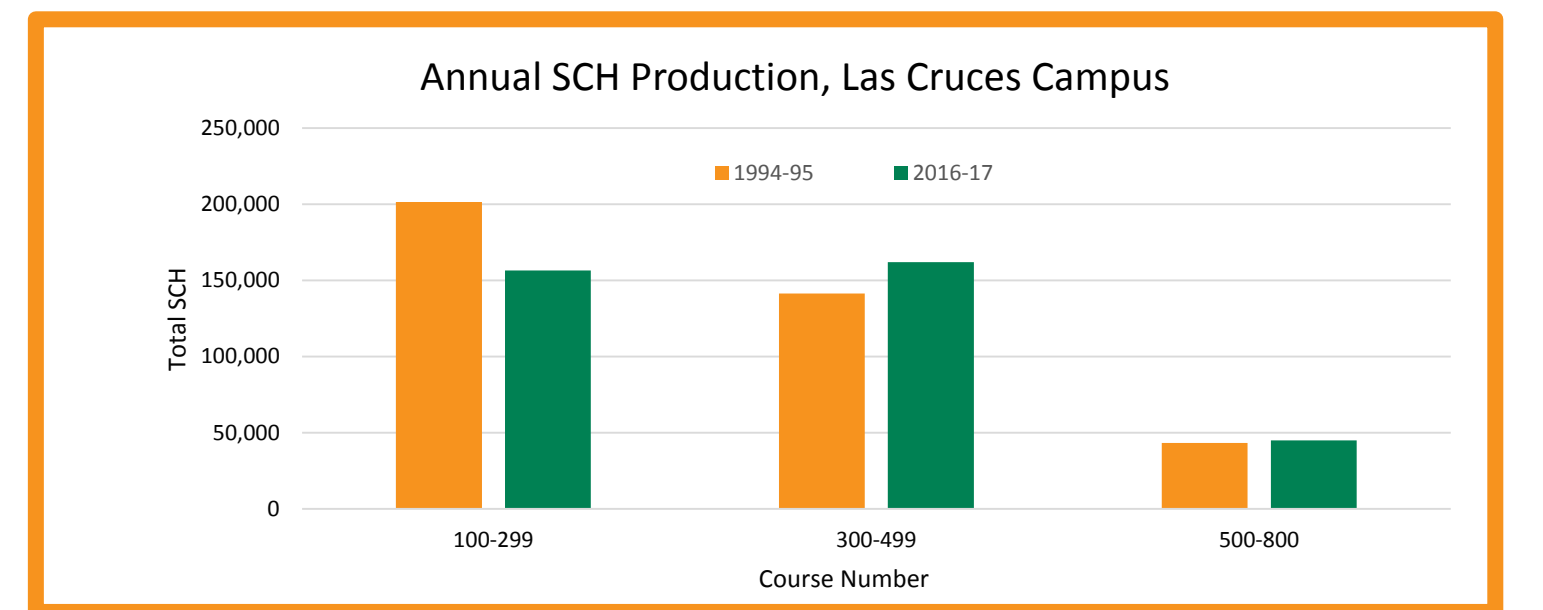
