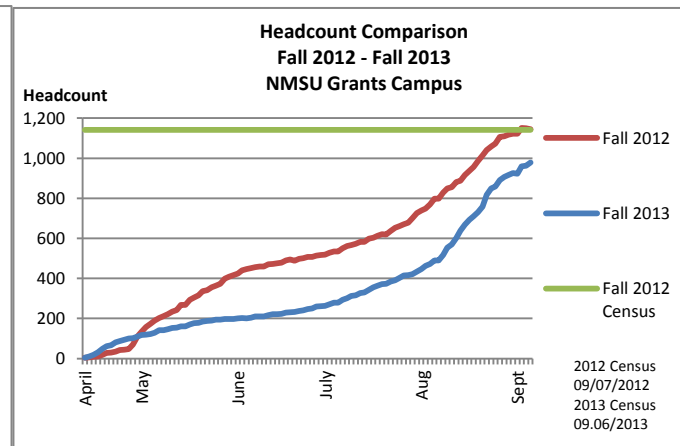
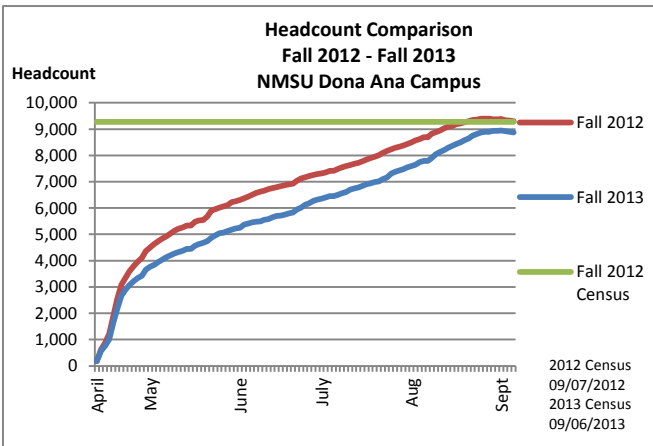
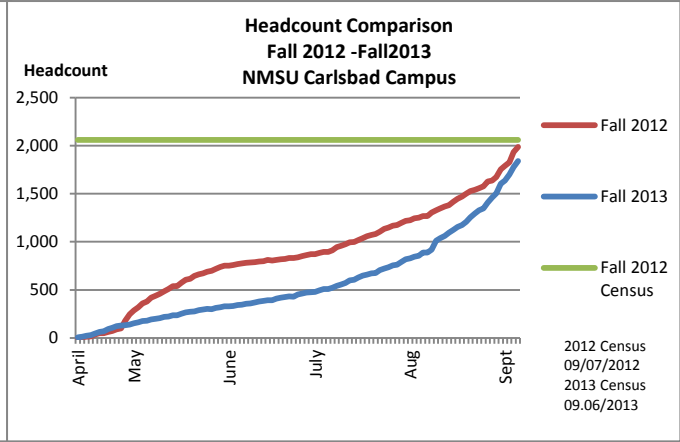
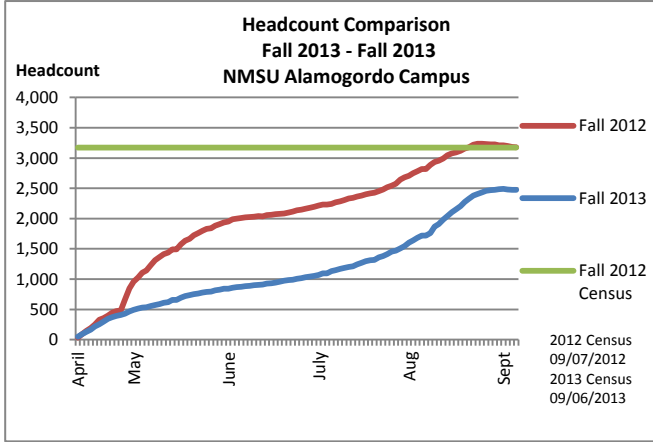
## Daily Campus Enrollment Comparison Graphs
