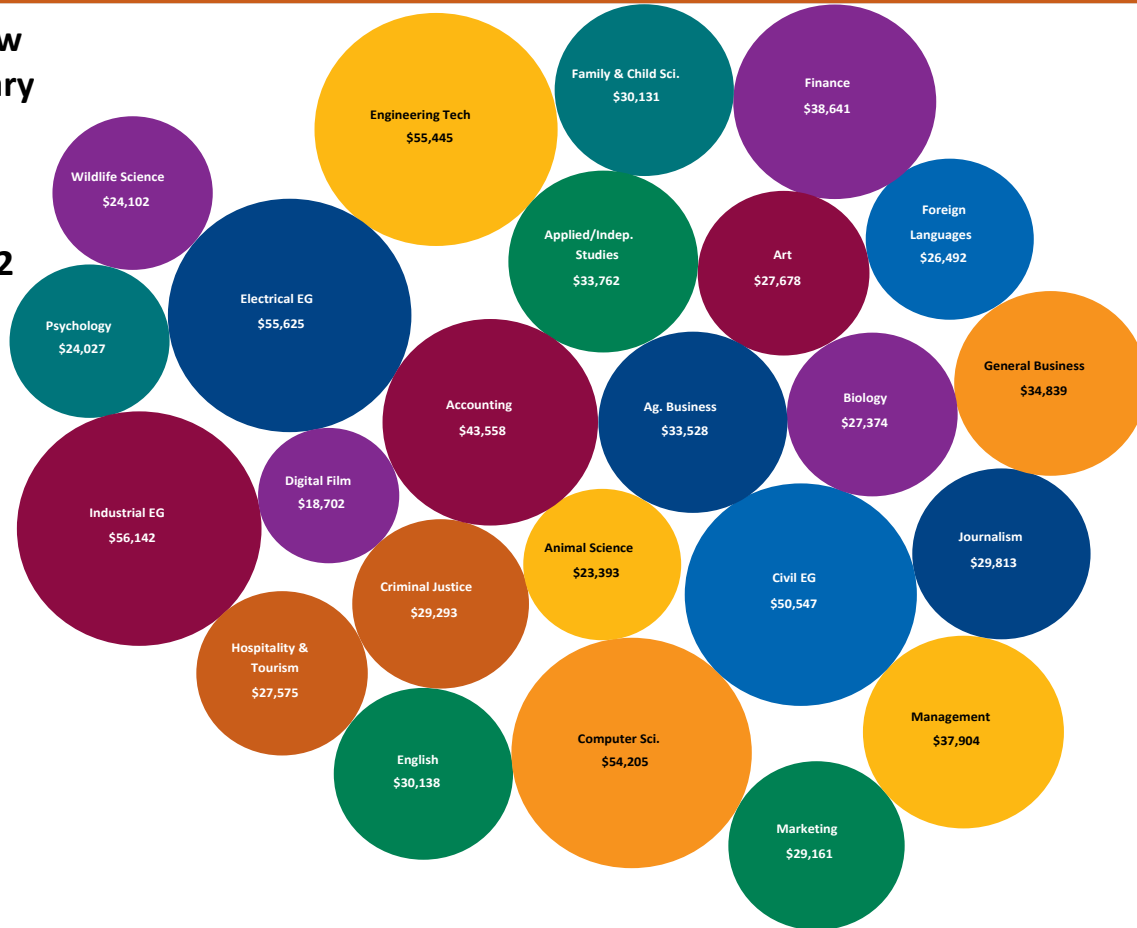
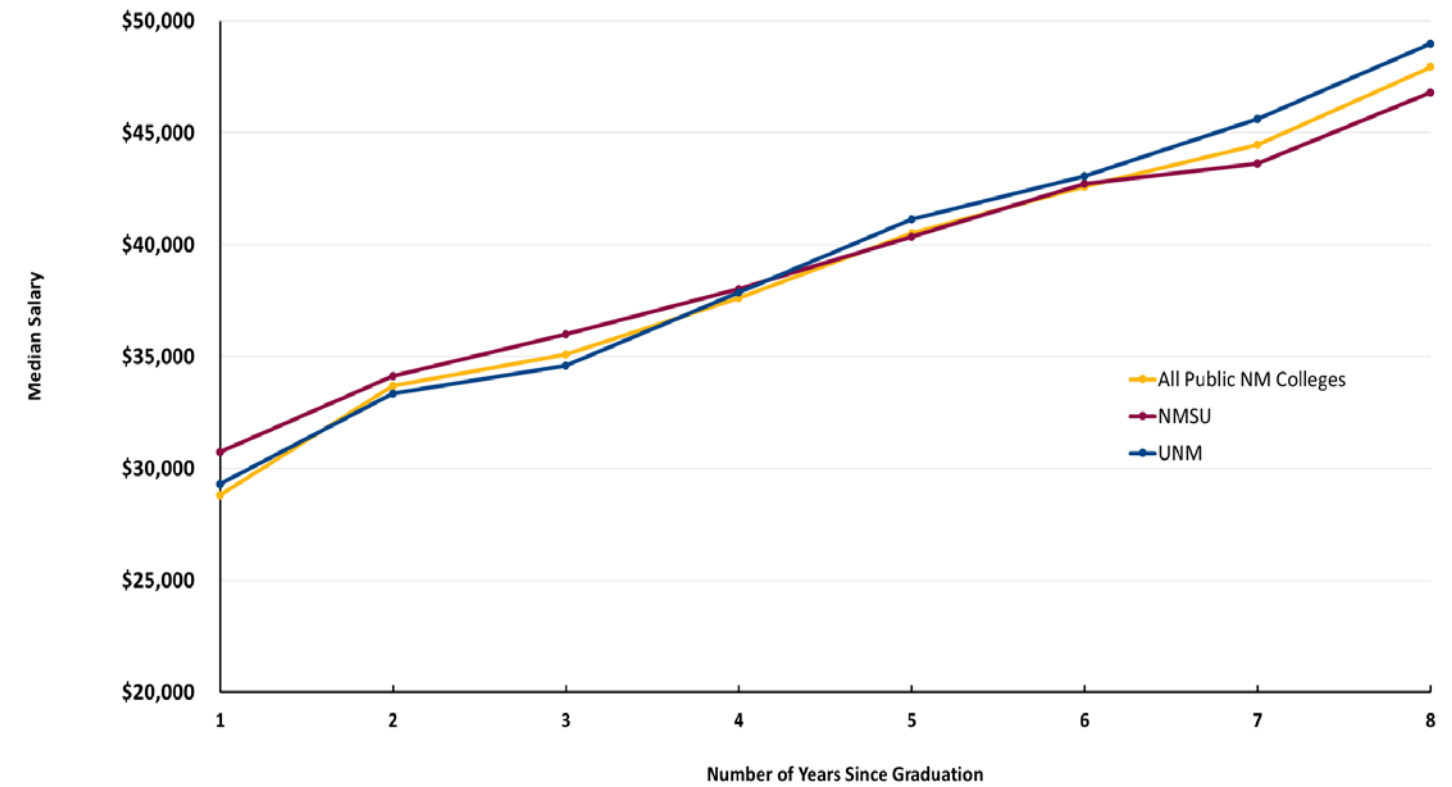

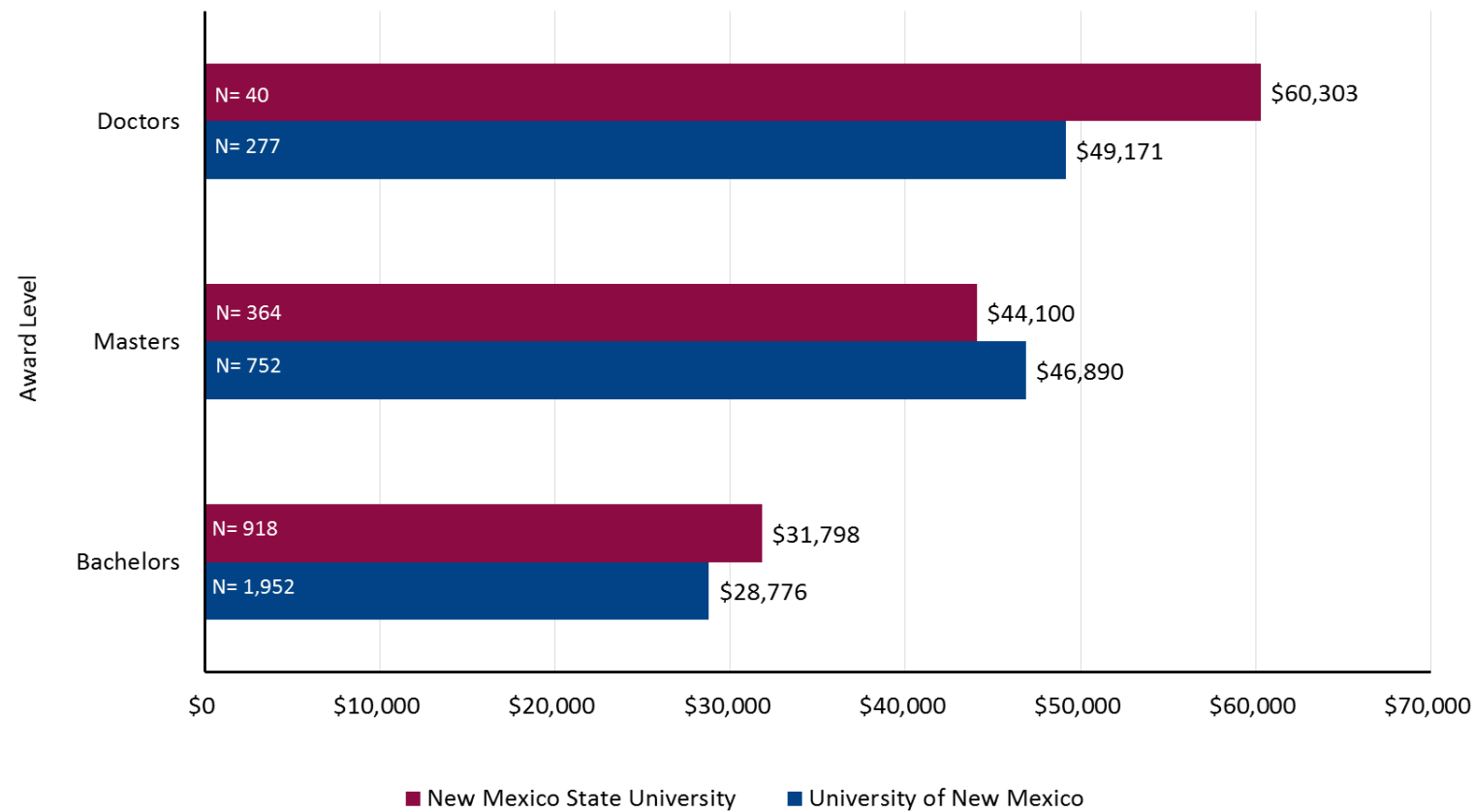
Average New Mexico Salary for 2012-13 Bachelor Degree Graduates, 2 Years After Graduation



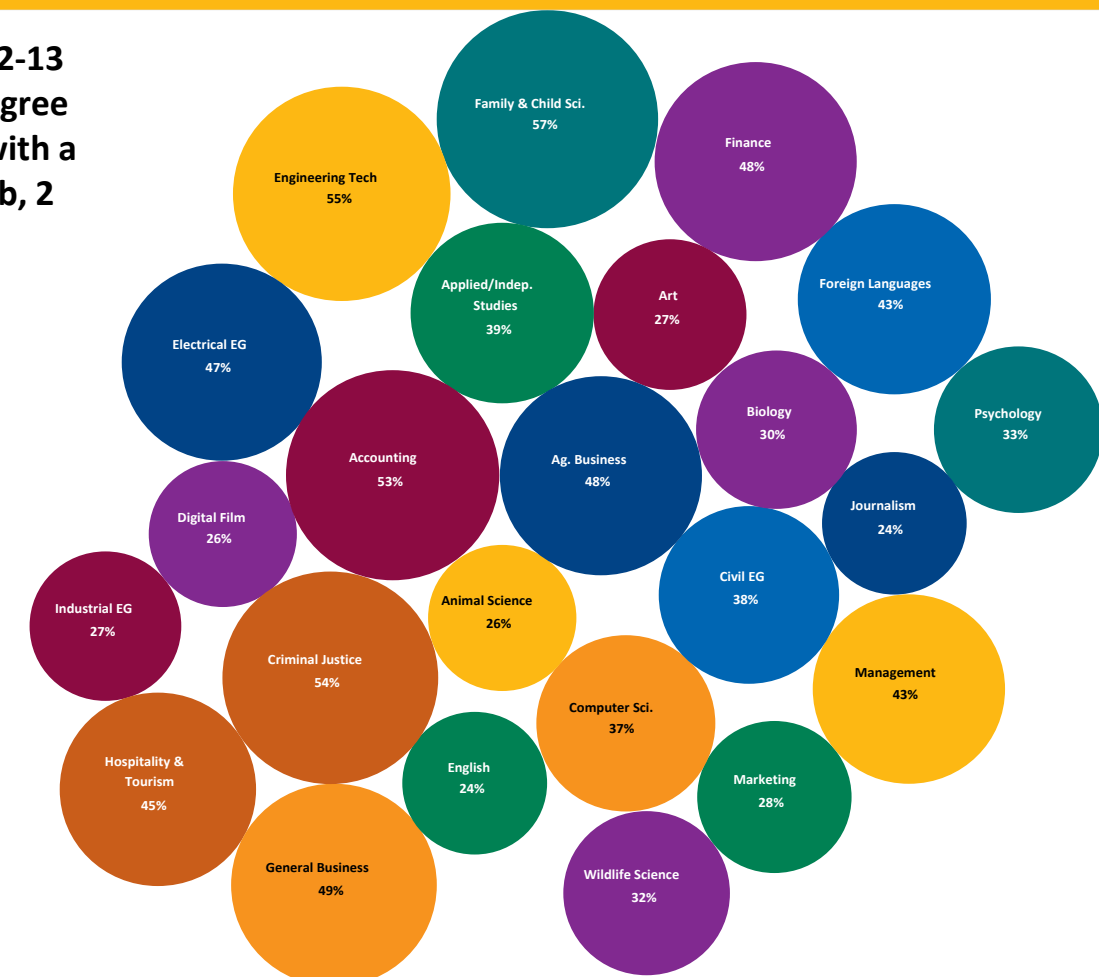
Median Salary of 2006-07 Bachelor Degree Graduates Working Full-Time in New Mexico by Number of Years Since Graduation



Median Salary and Number of Graduates Working Full-Time in New Mexico 1 Year After Graduation, 2013-14 Graduates



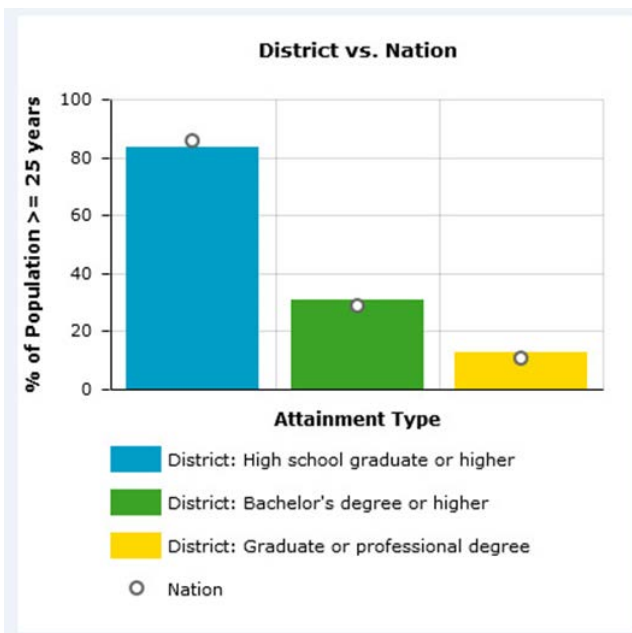
Percent 2012-13 Bachelor Degree Graduates with a Full-Time Job, 2 Years After Graduation



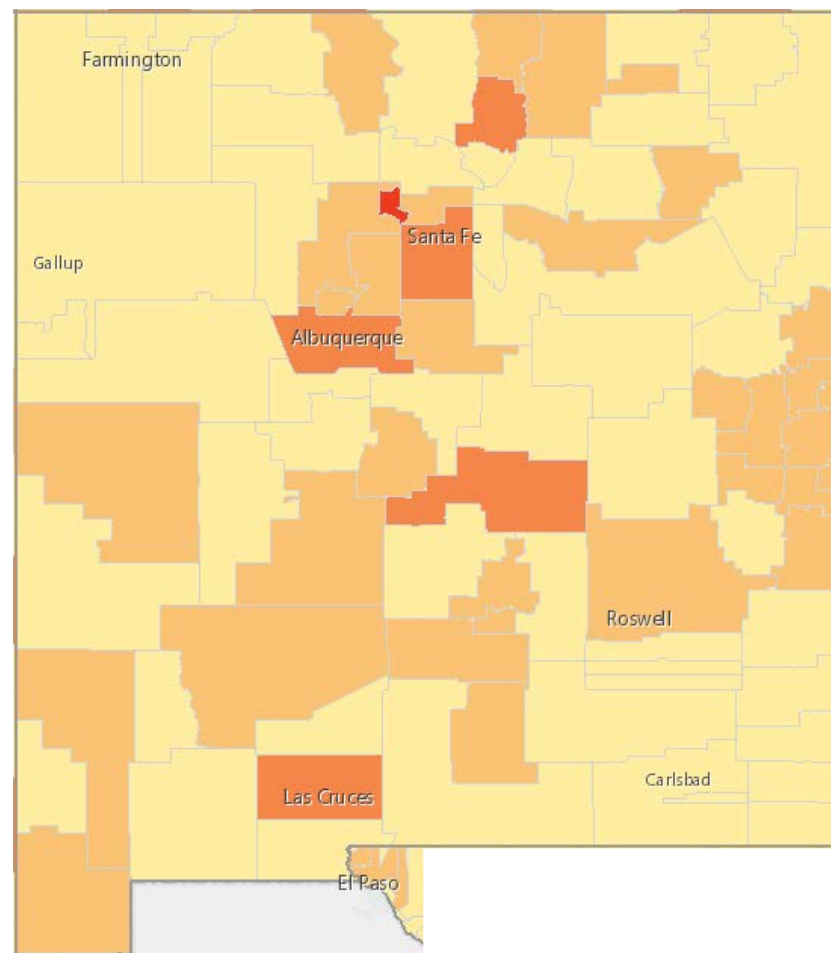

Graduate or Professional Degree: 12.6%

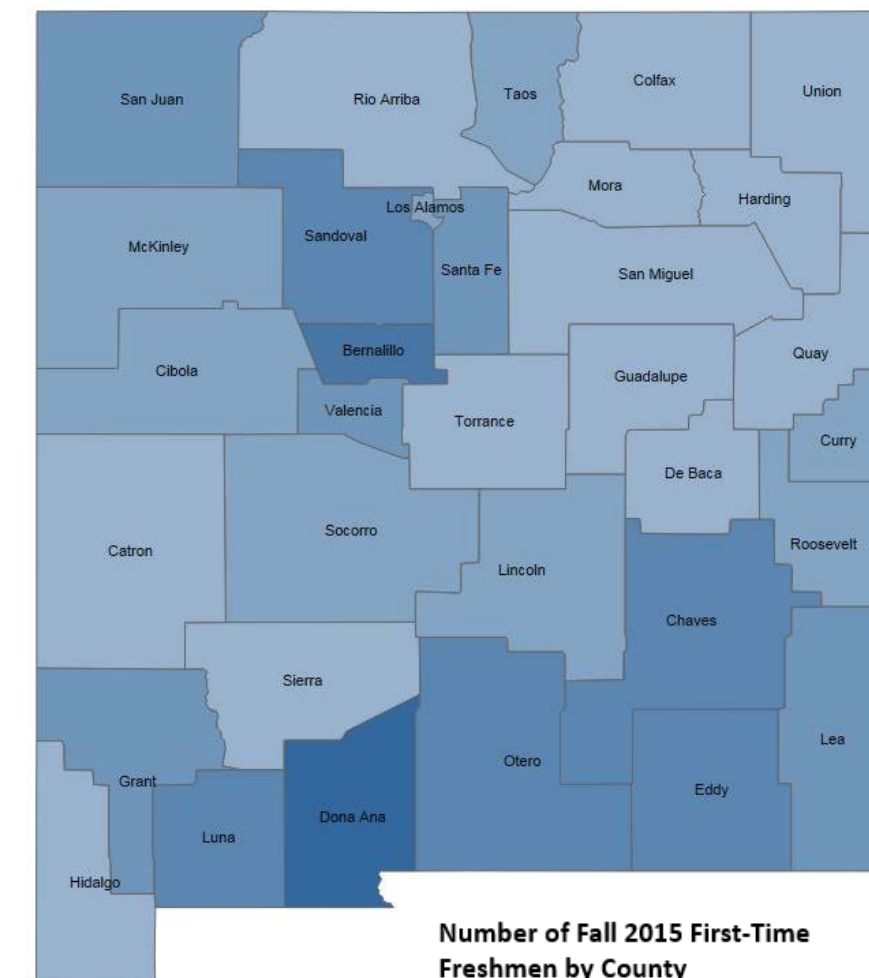


Percent of Population with a Bachelor's Degree or Higher

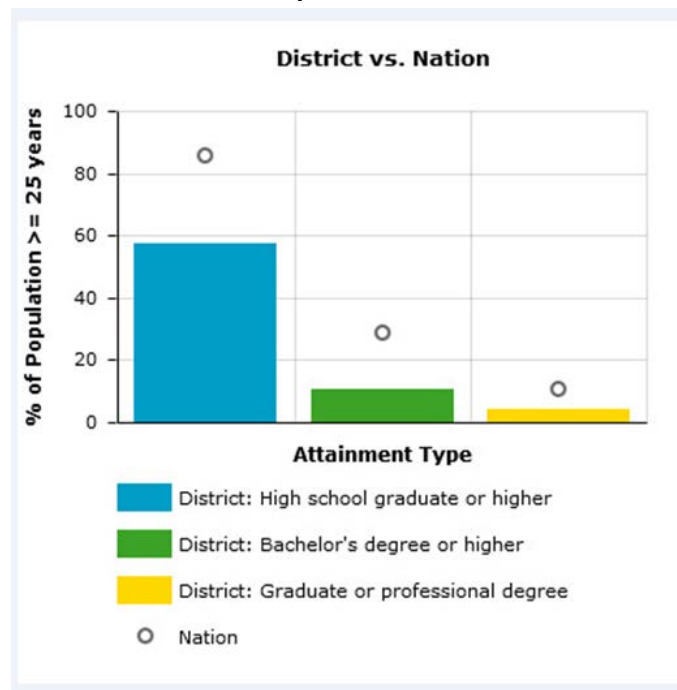

Number of Fall 2015 First-Time Freshmen by County

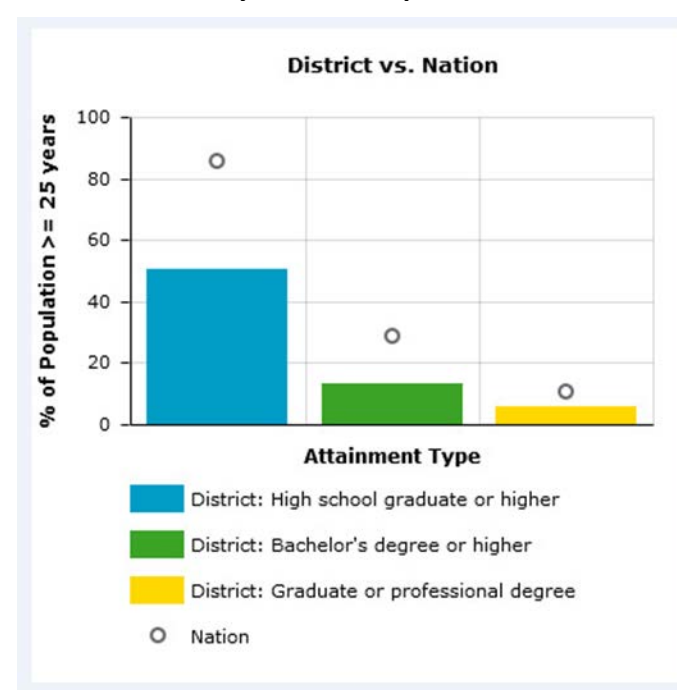
