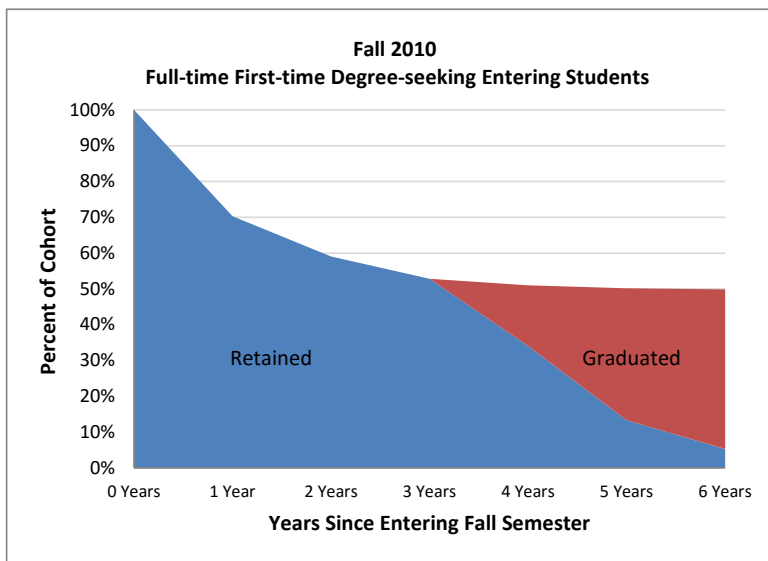
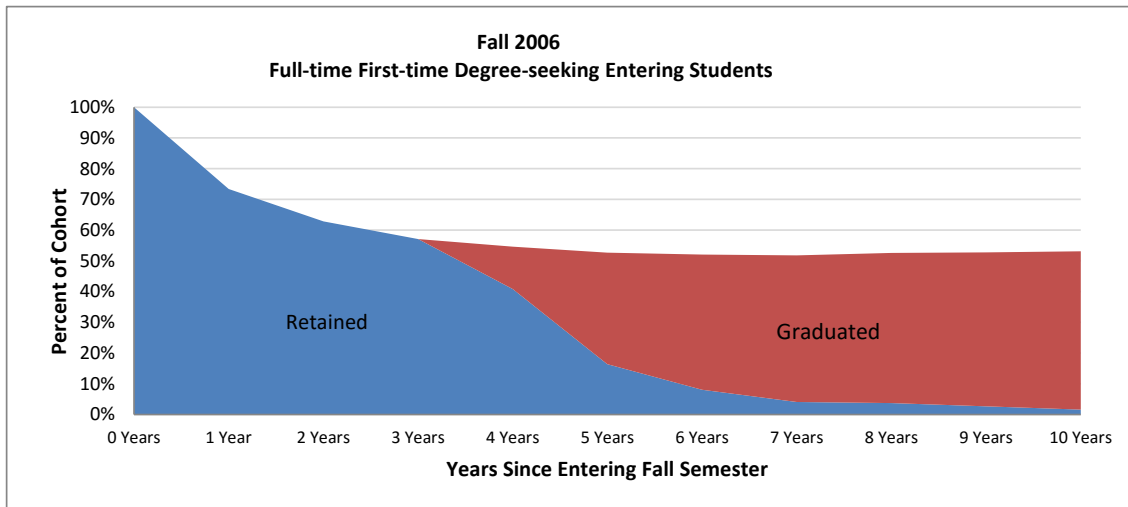

**Graduated:** Received a bachelor degree
