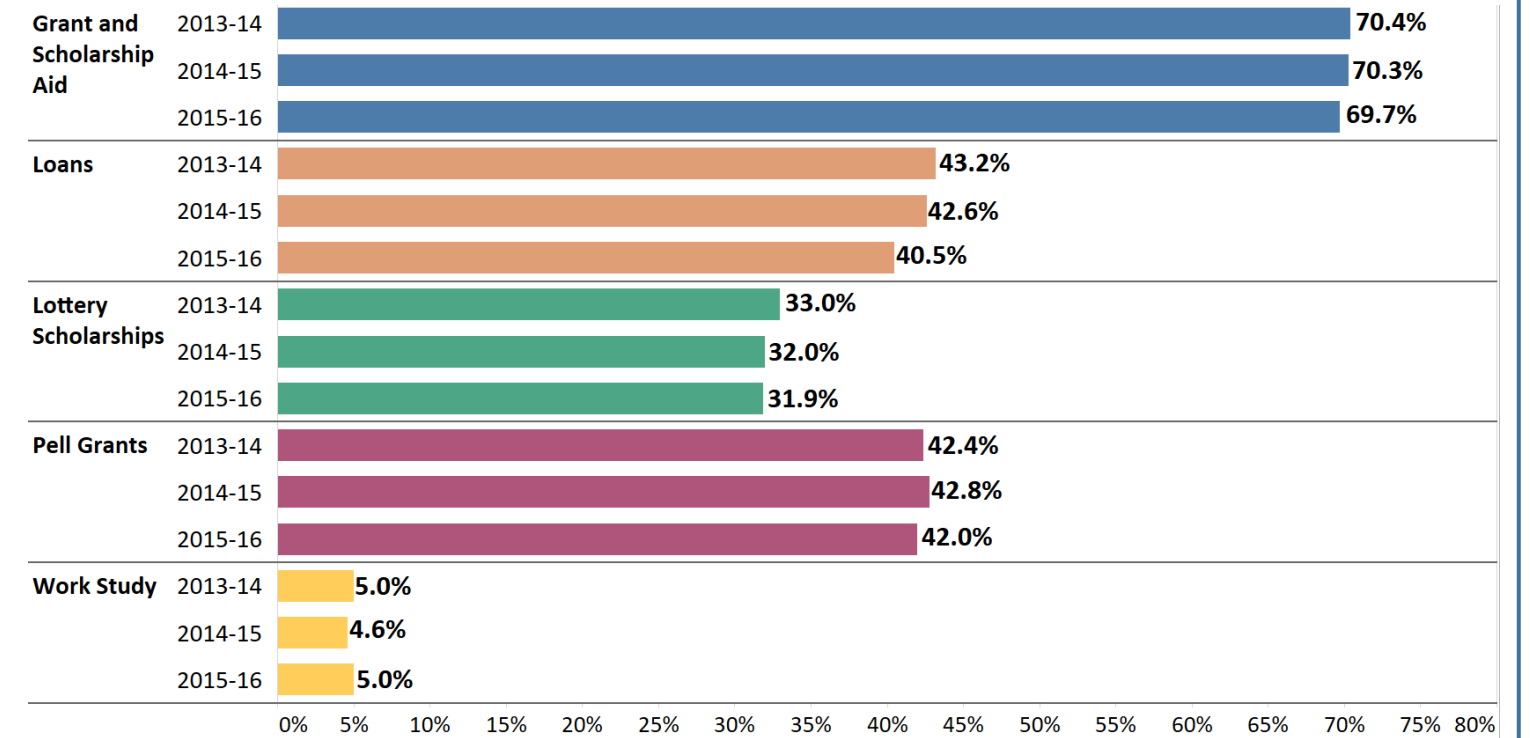

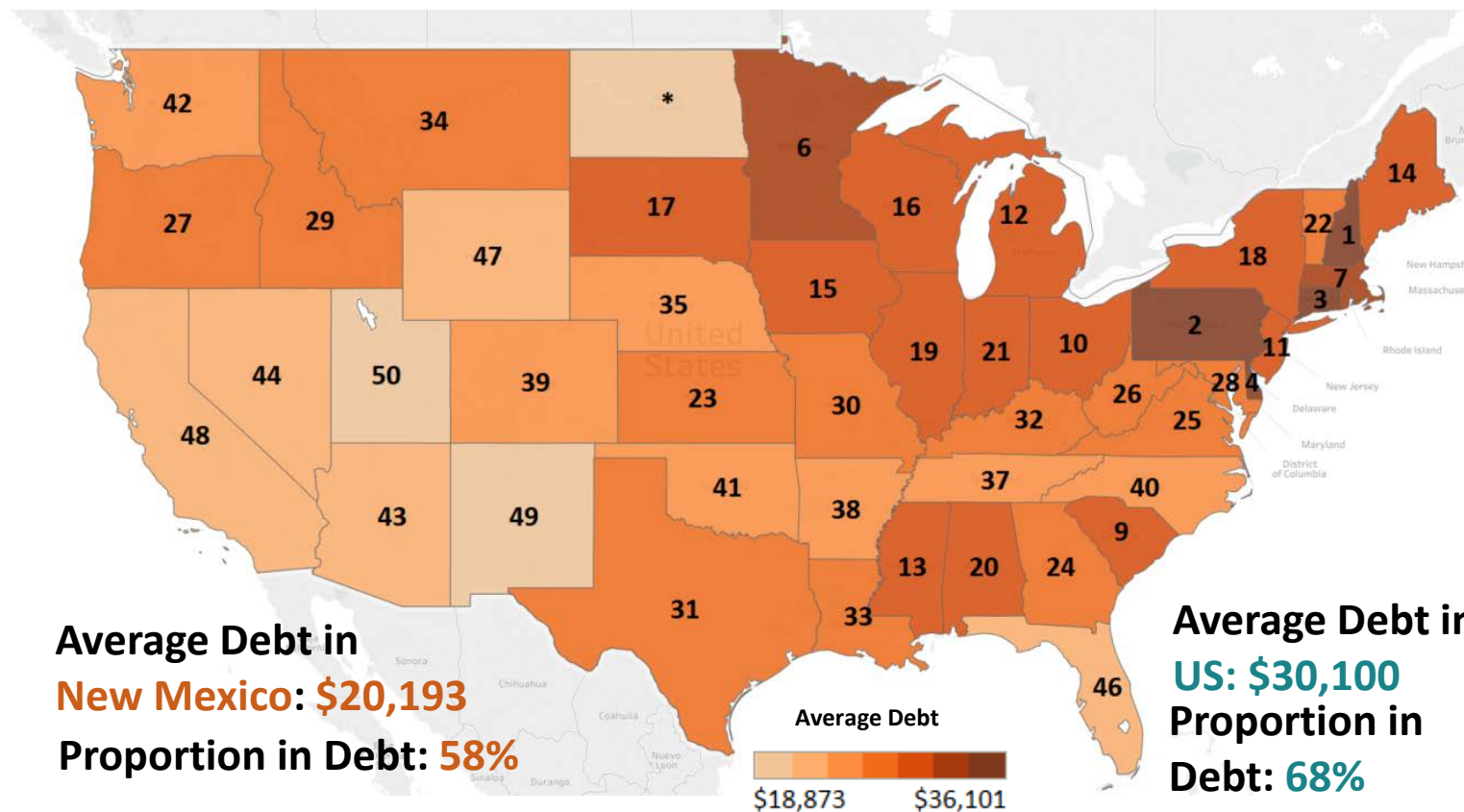

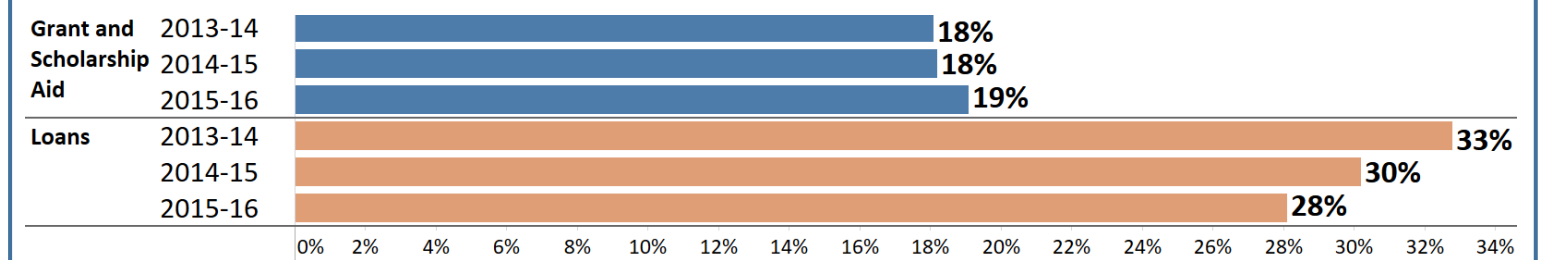
Percentage of Undergraduate Students Receiving Financial Aid, 2013-14 to 2015-16



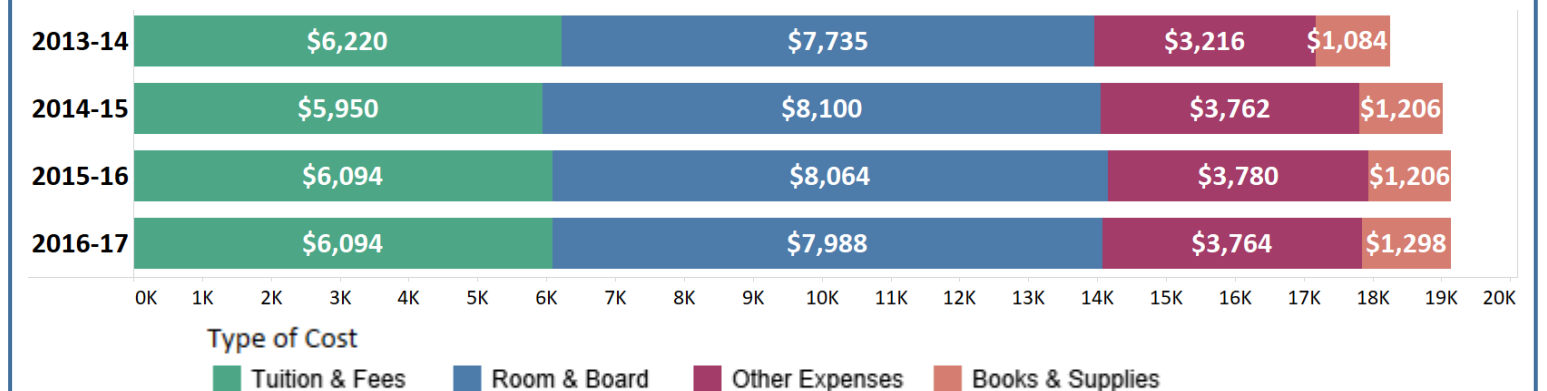
State Rankings Based on Average Amount of Undergraduate Debt at Graduation, Class of 2015



Percentage of Graduate Students Receiving Financial Aid, 2013-14 to 2015-16



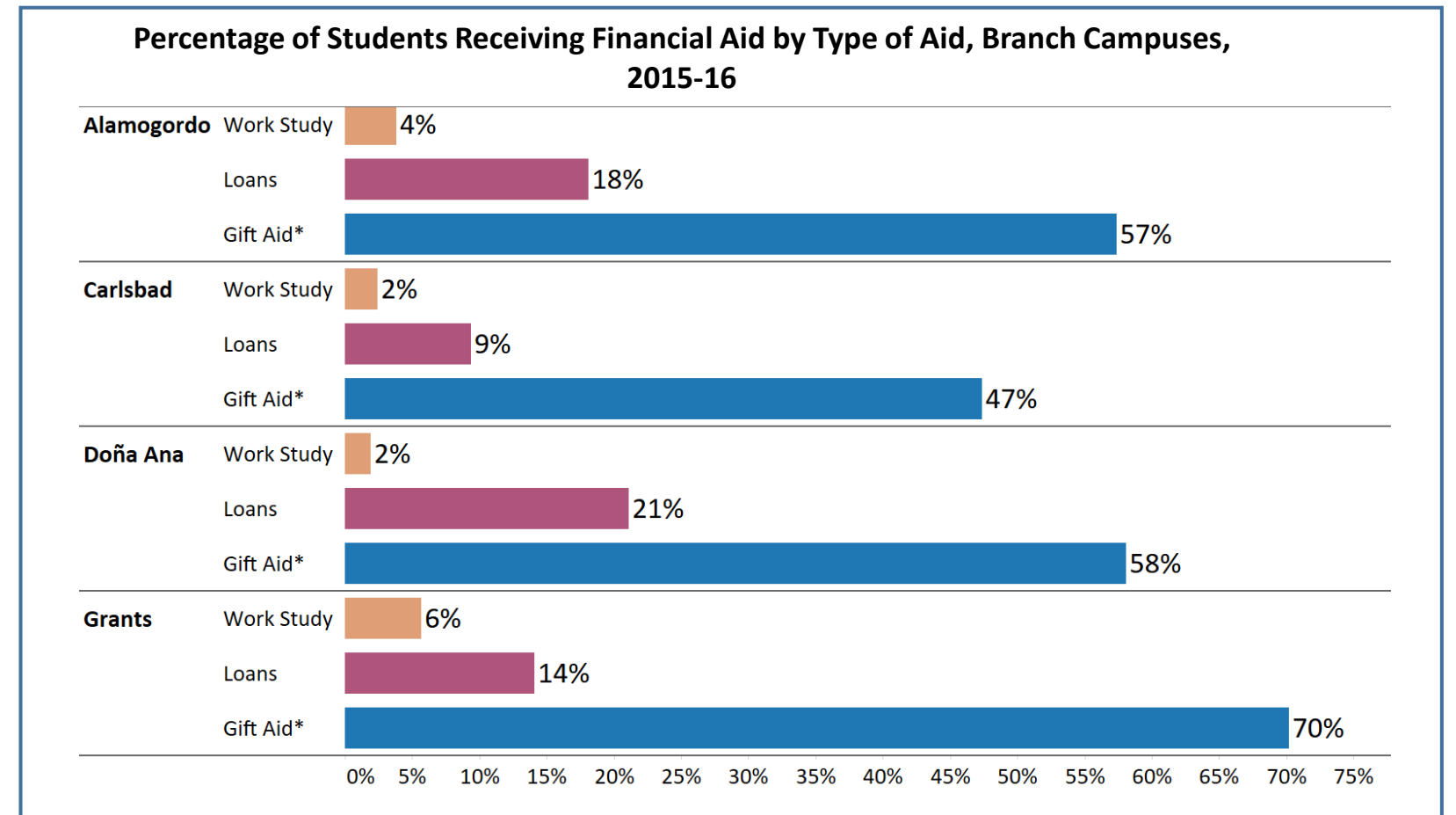
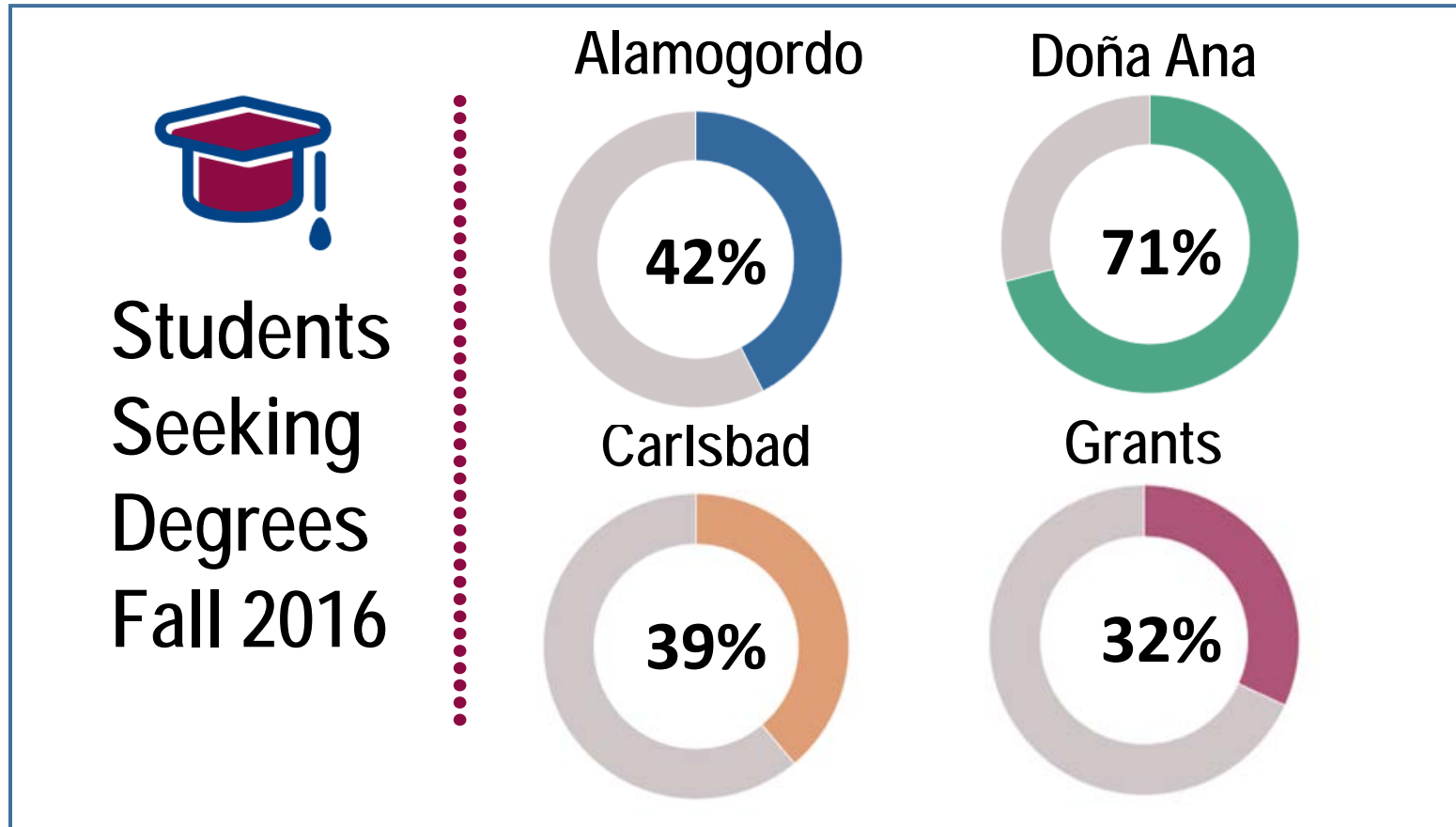
Cost of Attendance for In-State, Full-Time Undergraduate Students, 2013-14 to 2016-17
