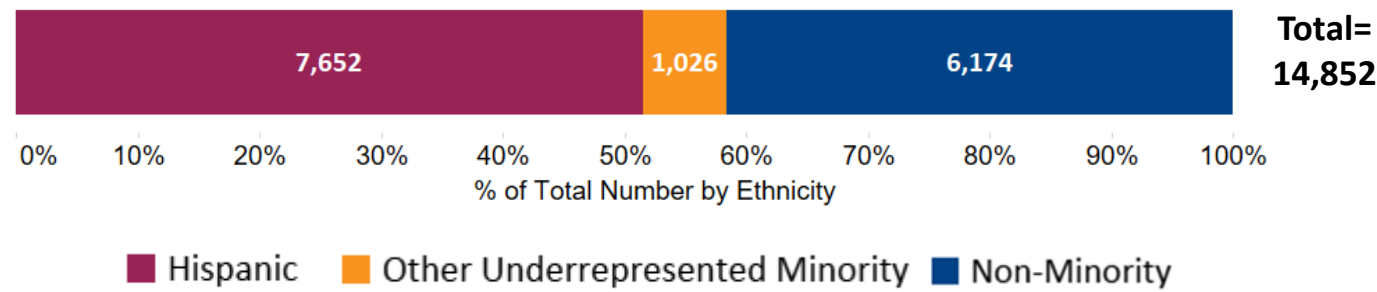
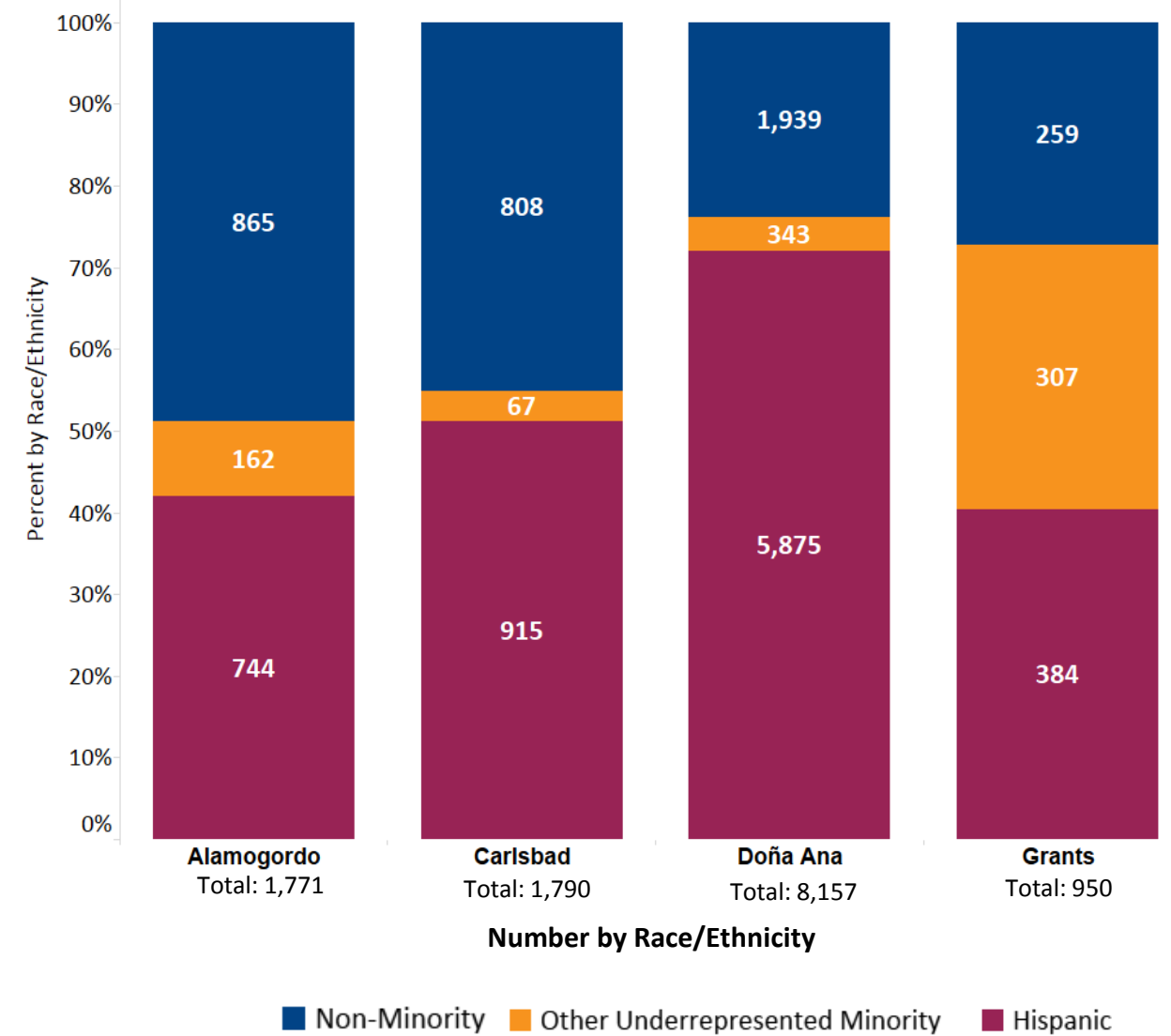

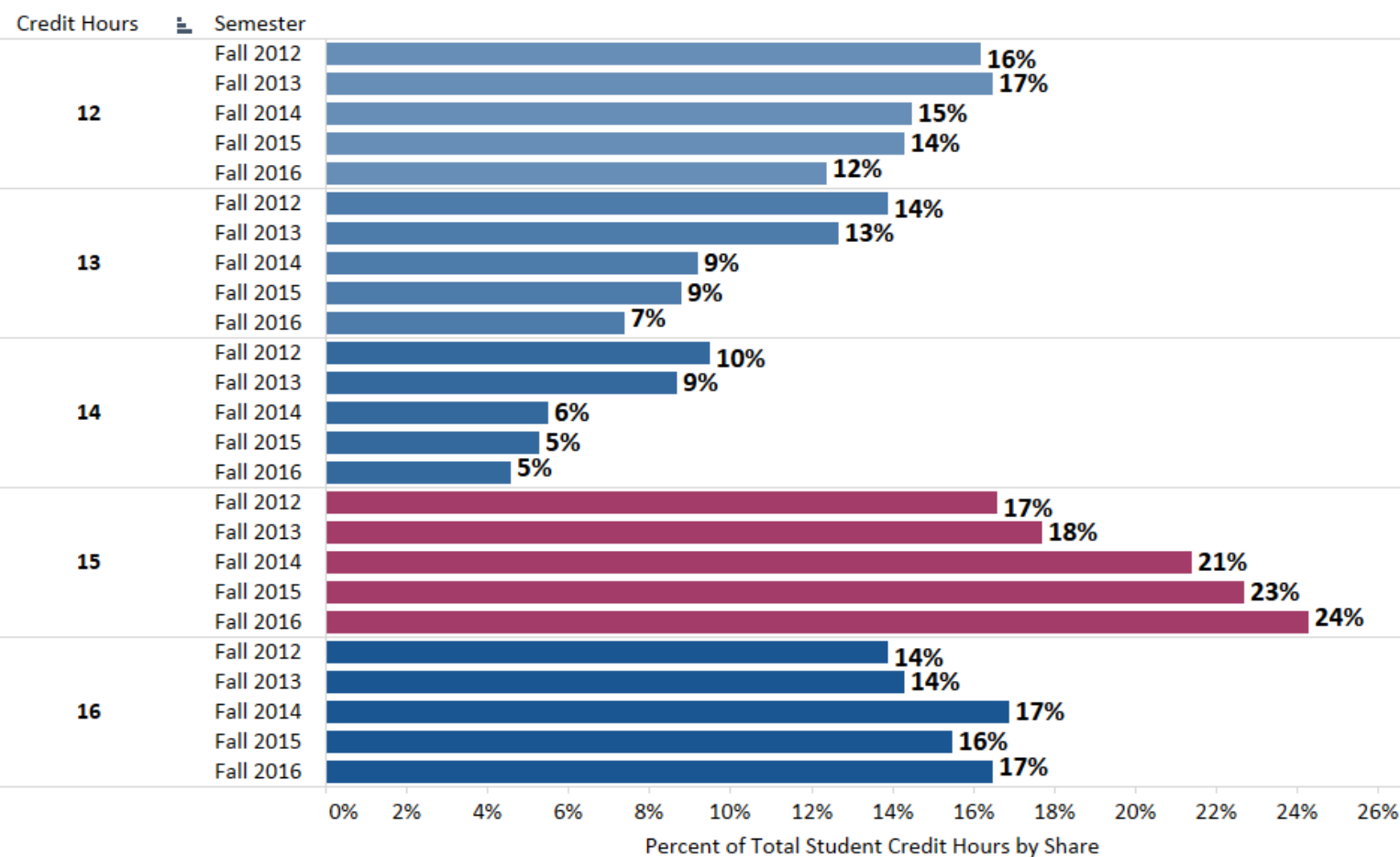
Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, Fall 2016, New Mexico State University, All Students



Student Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, Fall 2016, Branch Campuses

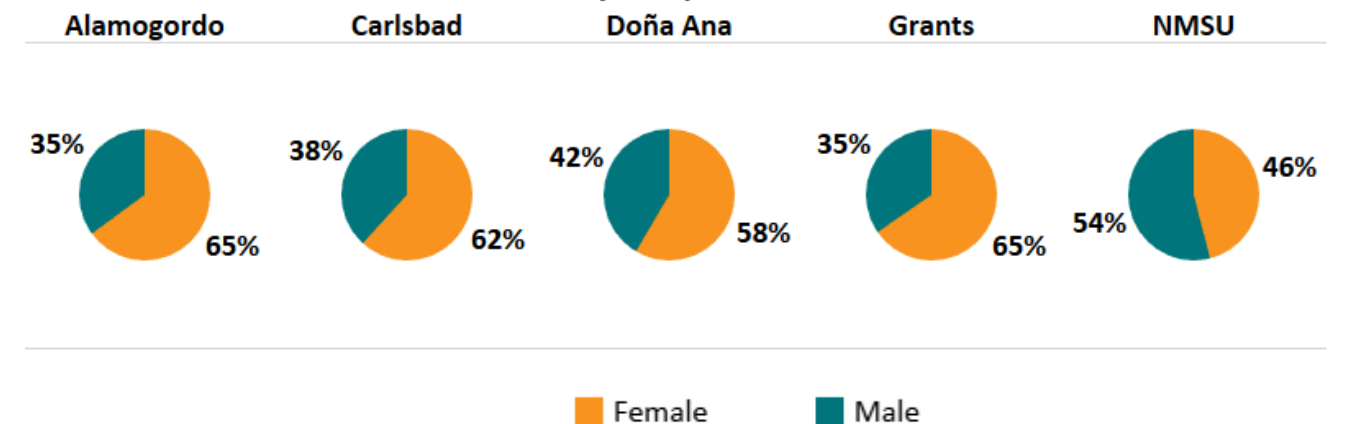


Undergraduate Student Credit Hours By Percent Share of Total, New Mexico State University, Fall 2012 - Fall 2016

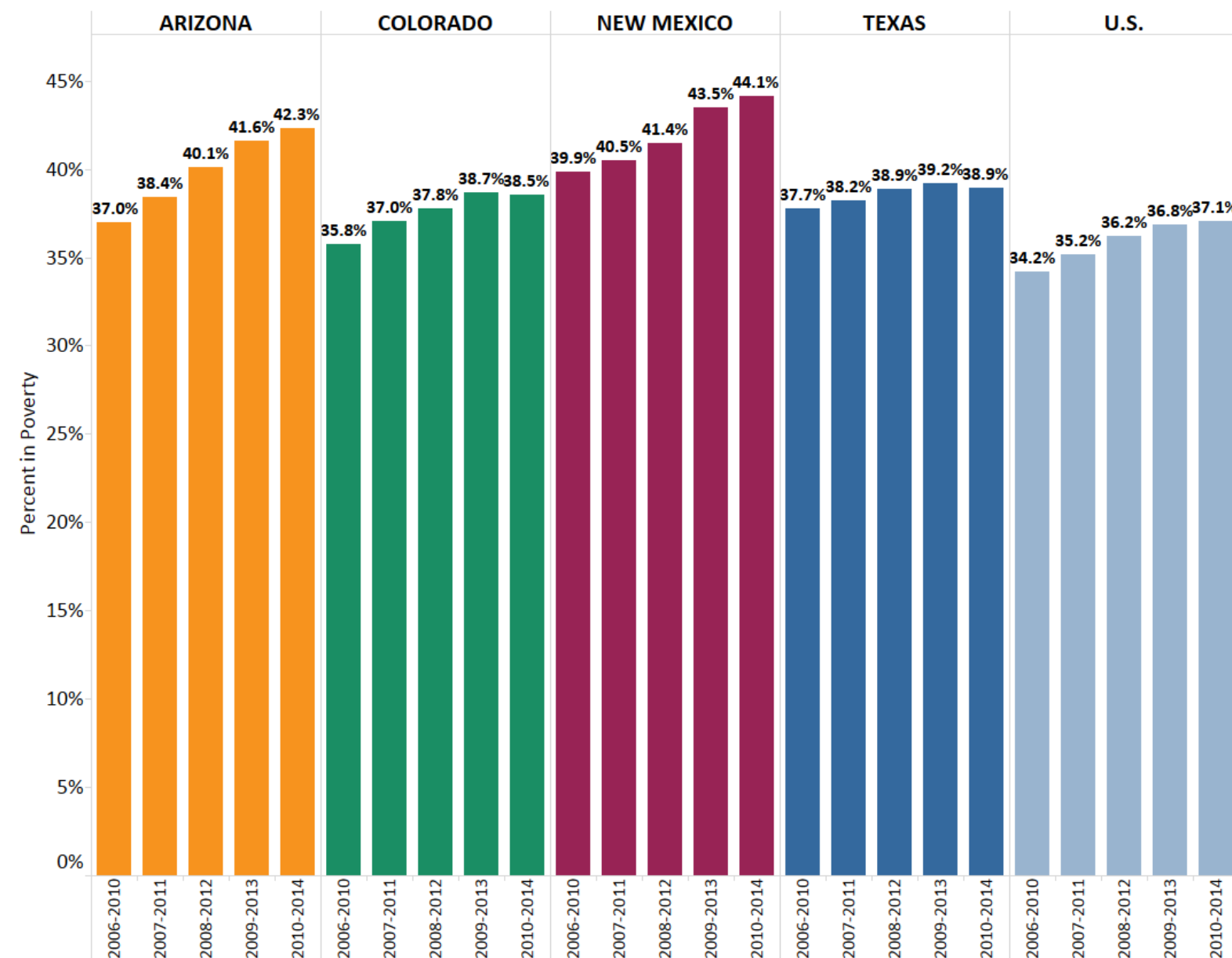

Percent of 18-24 Years Olds Living in Poverty: ACS 2006-2014



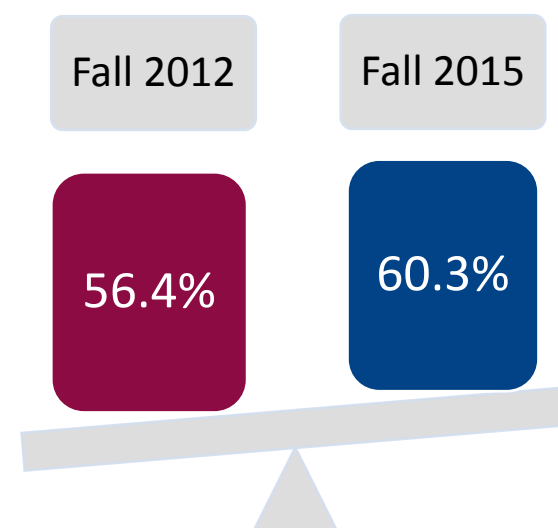
